On Campus Highlight



Logic Field Trip to City Hall

In Logic, students explored how developing and engaging with arguments underlies change and community building. Students are working toward making policy proposals to IVA High administration to **directly impact our community**.

To enrich and deepen the connection between argument and community impact, Logic students were invited to tour Long Beach City Hall. They toured the council chamber and Mayor Rex Richardson's office @rexrichardsonlb, took in the view from the mayors balcony, and engaged in discussion with policy makers on the problems facing Long Beach, the challenges to policy making, how argument underlies community change, and why one might choose to dedicate their time to public service.





Engineering: Environmental Sustainability & Water Filters

Students in Mr. Sallam's environmental sustainability class created a filtering device that tackled the **three challenges of environmental sustainability**: renewable energy, a lack of clean water, and a lack of affordable food. The challenge was to make the device with recyclable materials.

Students designed their filters using the engineering design process which involved obtaining data, making sure the filter addressed one of the above issues, and testing the filter to make adjustments or revisions. Students worked in groups to present their filters to the class, and offer feedback to each other. The class will be presenting their filters to the community at Exhibition of Learning!
